We commit to working respectfully to honour their ongoing cultural and spiritual connections to this country.

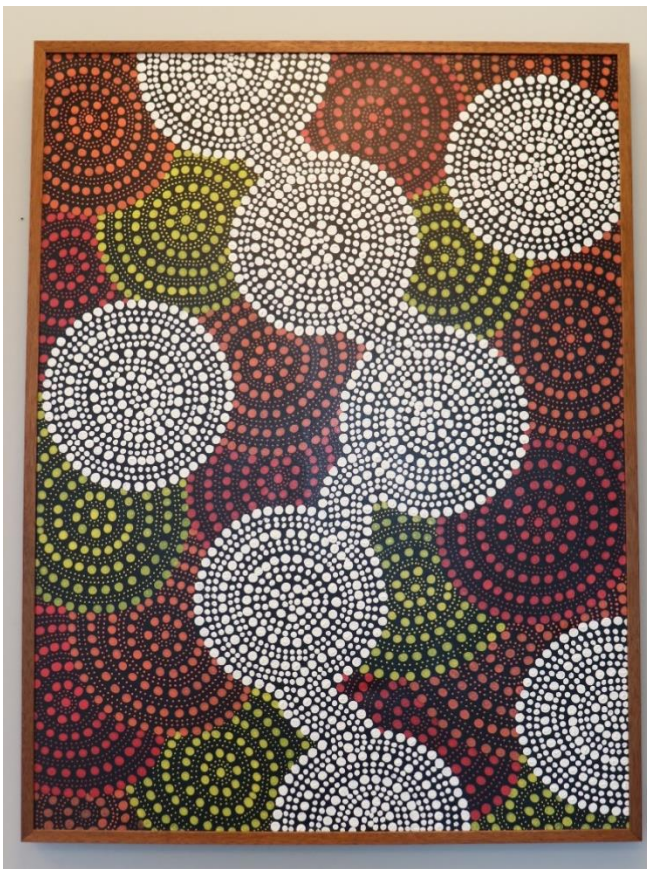

We acknowledge the importance of working with all Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples as we walk together toward a healthier future.

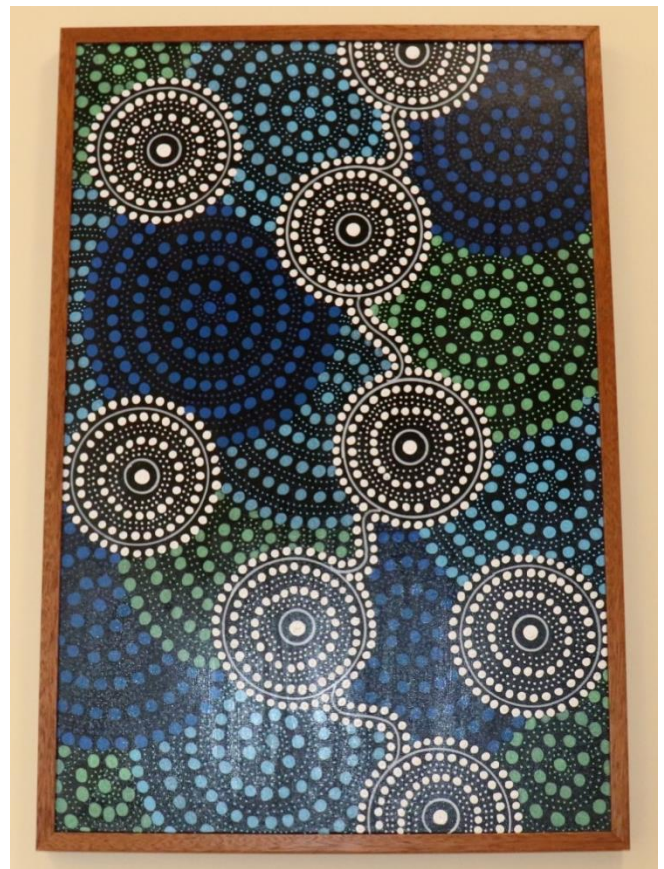
Gippsland Southern Health Service has now on display two pieces of Aboriginal artwork in the foyer of both the Leongatha and Korumburra hospital sites.
